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About Where the Heart Is

Mission

Create a sense of belonging in a safe and caring environment to build and enhance services for youth in transition

Vision

Provide Kentucky state agency children with a transitional safety net in all educational settings

“Where the Heart Is” is a network of caring educators with the common goal of creating a sense of welcome and belonging for students transitioning to new schools and education programs. Going to a new school is difficult for any student, but at-risk students coming from alternative settings face additional barriers. Many of these youth have been in alternative placements due to abuse, neglect and behavioral challenges. One of the greatest fears these kids have is returning to their original schools, environments where perhaps they were “getting in trouble” or falling behind academically.

“Where the Heart Is” seeks out individuals who are actively engaged in the lives of Kentucky youth. The program aims to provide a tool in the form of the “Where the Heart Is” symbol. This tool can be displayed in your work area so that transitioning youth and people impacting the youth of this state can recognize each other. The symbol is the metaphorical bridge which is meant to provide a connection between placements across the state and individuals that are working with youth in more traditional academic settings. The potential to impact troubled youth at this crucial point in their lives is huge. It could be as simple as opening your door or showing an interest in a young person’s life.

Origin

In 2007, a study was conducted to find out valuable information about the nature of transition for some of Kentucky’s most vulnerable students. The Kentucky Youth At-Risk Transitions research team was comprised of members from the Kentucky Educational Collaborative for State Agency Children (KECSAC) and the Department of Occupational Therapy and College of Education at Eastern Kentucky University. This study and it’s followup research, Building Enhanced Services for Transition (BEST Study), inspired one of the programs whose students were being studied to take action. Ramey-Estep High School staff began collaborating with surrounding schools to ease their students’ transitions back into those settings. This pilot transition program evolved into “Where the Heart Is.” With its logo designed by a student and already displayed in several schools across the state, it is the hope that eventually any student going through the difficult process of transition will be able to find an ally to help ease their journey.

About this Guide

This guide was developed in order to give “Where the Heart Is” contacts a quick reference manual for national, state and local resources that could be used to aid transitioning students. This guide will be updated as new resources are discovered, and users are encouraged to update their own manuals as they become aware of useful services in their own areas. At the end of the guide is a page to fill in with local contact information. You may also refer to the KECSAC (Kentucky Educational Collaborative for State Agency Children) Program Directory for a list of programs serving state agency children, many of which offer community assistance, treatment and counseling programs. We hope that you will not only find this guide useful in your work with transitioning students, but with any youth needing additional services.

About the Logo

The “Where the Heart Is” logo was designed by a student in a state agency children program and is a reflection of the idea behind the program. The logo is meant to be displayed on doors or in classrooms or offices of those people that have identified themselves as contacts for transitioning students. It’s as simple as that: hang the symbol and students will know you are a safe person to come talk to. Participants at “Where the Heart Is” trainings will receive laminated copies of the logo to display and additional copies can be printed from the KECSAC website.

About the Card

Participants at “Where the Heart Is” trainings will also receive “Where the Heart Is” contact cards. These cards are to be given to students transitioning out of programs. The front of the card has the logo, so the student will recognize it when they see it in their new program or school. The back of the card has room for contact information. If the transitioning program knows of a “Where the Heart Is” contact or a transition specialist at the new school, that information can be placed on the card. Or that space can be used to record the information for the contact or transition specialist of the sending program, so that the student can get in touch with him or her after departing. Use this card in the way that best works for you. It is just one more resource to help students feel like they are not alone during a difficult time.

How to Start

- Attend a Where the Heart Is training or simply download the logo from the KECSAC Website.
- Display the logo in your classroom or office to identify yourself as a safe and non-judgemental person to talk to.
- Be available to the students in your school who are transitioning and make them feel welcome.
- If you have contact with students who will be leaving your program or have input into transition plans, share the WTHI logo with those students. Resources for sharing that information are available on the KECSAC website.

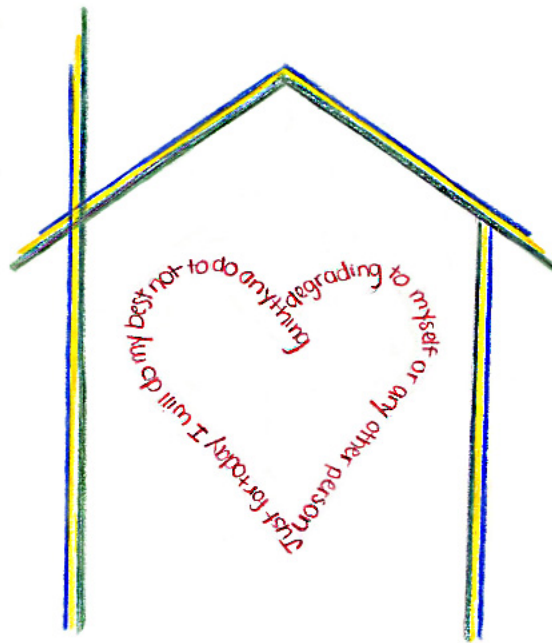
